## Note No : 1 Significant Accounting Policies for the Year Ended

(All amounts are in Indian Rupees Thousands except share data and as stated)

### 1.1 Corporate Information:

The objects of the company is to carry on the business of reselling and distributing hardware and software, Solution providing, software product development, Consultancy services relating to Business Process Reengineering and design and implementation of Information Technology and act as franchise agent for electronic information technology development, upgradation, manufacturing, processing of hardware, Software etc.

### Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

The financial statements of the Company have been prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in India (Indian GAAP) to comply with the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014 and the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 / Companies Act, 1956, as applicable. The financial statements have been prepared on an accrual basis and under the historical cost convention. The Accounting policies adopted in the preparation of financial statements are consistent with those followed in the previous year.

### 1.2. Significant Accounting Policies

#### a. Use of Estimates

The preparation of the financial statements in conformity with Indian GAAP requires the Management to make estimates and assumptions considered in the reported amounts of assets and liabilities (including Contingent Liabilities) and the reported income and expenses during the year. The management believes that the estimates used in preparation of the financial statements are prudent and reasonable. Future results could differ due to these estimates and the differences between the actual results and the estimates are recognized in the periods in which these get materialized.

#### b. Revenue recognition

- (i) Revenue from sale of goods is recognized when sufficient risks and rewards are transferred to customers, which is generally on dispatch of goods in case of domestic sales and on leaving of Indian shores in case of Export sales and sales are stated net of taxes, returns and discounts.
- (ii) Revenue from Services are recognized during the year in which the Services are rendered.
- (iii) Interest Income is recognized on accrual basis.

#### c. Property, Plant and Equipment

Property, Plant and Equipment are stated at cost of construction or acquisition less accumulated depreciation. All other expenses including taxes, duties, freight incurred to bring the Property, Plant and Equipment to working condition is also treated as the cost of the Property, Plant and Equipment. However, eligible Input Tax Credit in respect of the Property, Plant and Equipment is deducted from the cost of the Plant, Property and Equipment.

Property, Plant and Equipment are stated at acquisition cost less accumulated depreciation or amortization and cumulative impairment.

#### d. Depreciation

Depreciation on Property, Plant & Equipment are provided on the Written Down Value Method over the useful lives of the assets prescribed under Part C of Schedule II of the Companies Act 2013. Depreciation for assets purchased/sold during the period is proportionately charged.

Intangibles assets, if any, are amortized over their respective individual estimated lives on a Written Down Value basis, commencing from the date the asset is available to the company for its use.

#### e. Inventories

Inventories are valued at cost or net realisable value, whichever is lower. Cost for the purpose of valuation of stocks purchased is determined by using the FIFO method, net of Input Tax Credit (if any)

- a) Raw Materials: Raw materials are valued at cost or net realisable value, whichever is lower.
- b) Finished Goods: Finished goods are valued at the lower of the cost or net realizable value.
- c) Stock In Transit: Stock in trade are valued at cost or net realizable value, whichever is lower.

#### f. Foreign Currency Transaction

Transactions in foreign currency are recorded at the exchange rate prevailing on the date of transactions and realized exchange gain/loss is dealt with in the Statement of Profit and Loss. Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies as at the balance sheet date are translated at the rate of exchange prevailing at the year-end. Exchange differences arising on actual payments/realizations and year-end restatements are dealt with in the Statement of Profit and Loss.

#### g. Provisions

A provision is recognized if, as a result of a past event, the Company has a present obligation that can be estimated reliably and it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation. Provisions are recognized at the best estimate of the expenditure to settle the present obligation as on the Balance Sheet date.

#### h. Contingent Liabilities and Contingent Assets

A contingent liability exists when there is a possible but not probable obligation, or a present obligation that may, but probably will not, result in an outflow of resources, or a present obligation whose amount cannot be estimated reliably. Contingent assets are neither recognized nor disclosed in the financial statements.

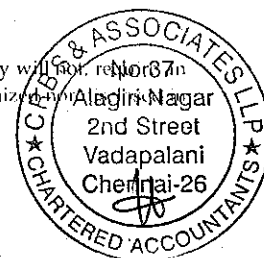

## Note No : 1 Significant Accounting Policies for the Year Ended

### i. Earnings Per Share

Basic earnings per share are calculated by dividing the Net Profit or Loss for the year attributable to equity shareholders by the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year.

(iii) Deferred Tax Asset is recognized and carried forward only to the extent that there is virtual certainty with convincing evidence that there will be sufficient future income to recover such deferred tax asset.

### l. Employee Benefits

#### a. Defined Contribution Plan:

Contribution as per the Employees provident fund & miscellaneous provisions Act 1952 towards provident fund & family pension fund are provided for and payments in respect thereof are made to relevant authorities on actual basis and accounted as an expense in the year it is incurred.

#### b. Defined Benefit Plan:

Gratuity & Leave Encashment:

The Company's liability towards retirement benefits in the form of Leave Encashment, Gratuity and Super Annuation are provided on the basis of estimations adopted by the Management as on the date of Balance Sheet.

Short term employee benefits are recognized as an expense at the undiscounted amount in the Statement of Profit and loss of the year in which the related services is rendered

Post-employment and other long term employee benefits are recognized as an expense in the Statement of Profit and loss for the year in which the employee has rendered services. The expenses are recognized on the basis of estimations adopted by the Management. Differences, if any, between the estimates of current year and previous year in respect of the post-employment and other long term benefits are charged to the Statement of Profit and loss.

### m. Borrowing Cost
